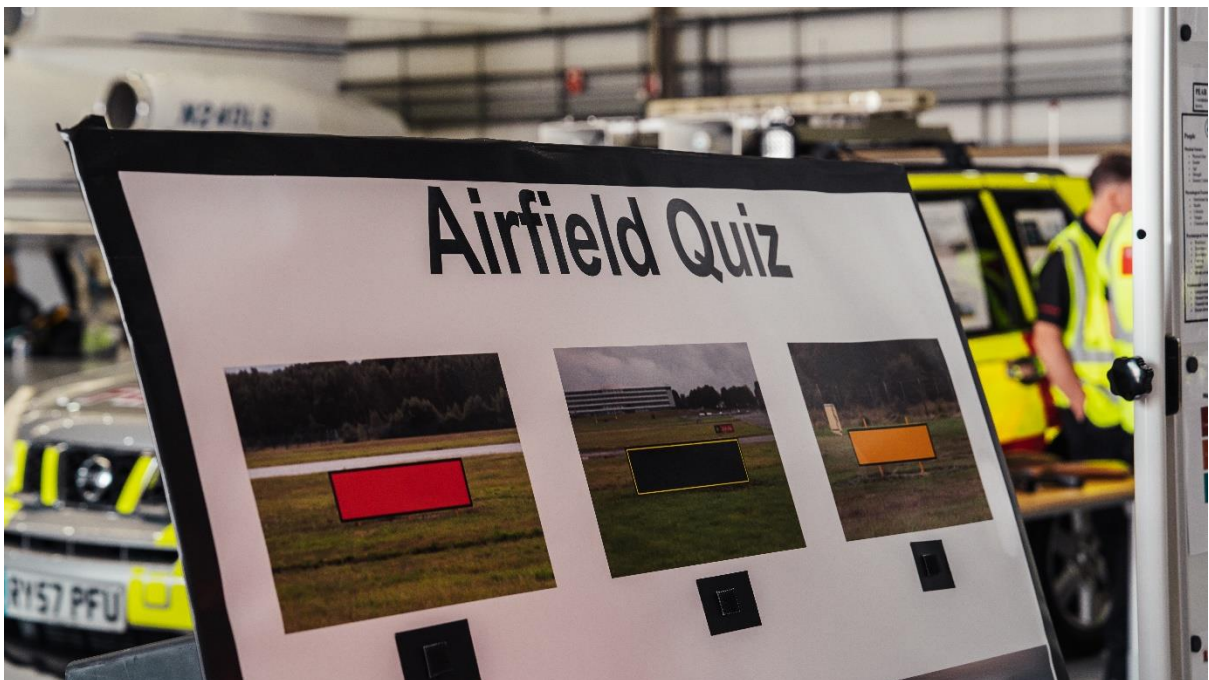
The event allowed staff to learn about the work of other airport departments and partner organisations.



The various safety displays allowed people to engage and learn new skills as well as form new friendships.



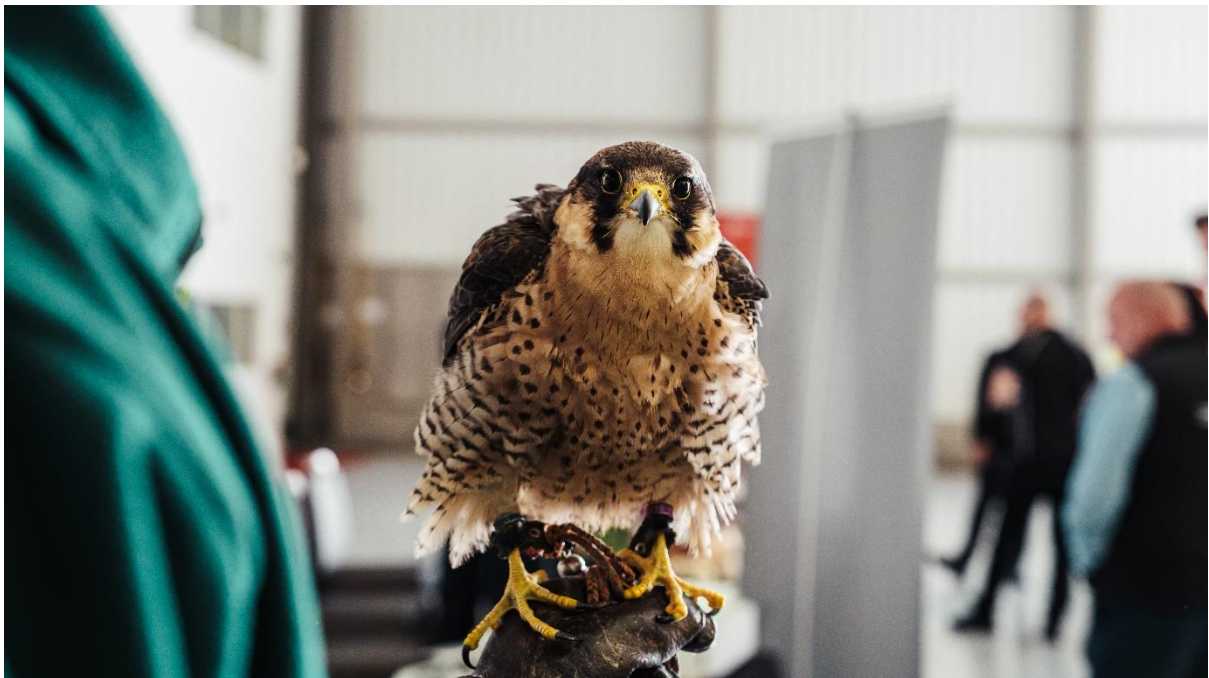
The Airside Safety Department were on hand to promote safe airside driving with a range of interactive quizzes and activities.
